BUSINESS OUTREACH

This section will help you:

- ☐ Identify supplies you need for your event
- ☐ Identify local businesses that may provide donations
- **☐** Reach out to prospective donors

BEST PRACTICES

Finding Donation Sources

- Ask around your school community, planning committee, etc. to see if there are established connections to local businesses
- Identify businesses/individuals that have donated in the past. That said, be careful not to constantly ask the same donors
- Remember that parents or faculty may be willing to donate

Tips for Approaching Businesses

- Call ahead to schedule a time to speak with the manager in person
- Bring a Donation Request Letter to the meeting
- Be specific about what you're seeking (gift cards, food, etc.)
- Consider inviting the business's employees to volunteer

Thanking Your Donors

- Consider acknowledging donors as event sponsors
- Send the Sponsor Thank You Letter to thank sponsors for donations, and to highlight the event's success

Here's a Tip!

Check with your supervisors to determine who should take charge of soliciting donations. This might be a good role for someone on your planning committee

Business Outreach Phone Script
